## TRANSMITTER LOCATION

Under our community broadcaster charter we are obliged to cover at least 50% of the physical population of Kangaroo Island.

Currently, our transmitter is located in a position that does not meet this obligation.

Investigations are underway to relocate back to Penneshaw which was originally listed as its prime site.

There are a couple sites we are looking at long term but more on that later.

As the main objective is to service 50% of the population we are making short to long term arrangements to achieve this goal.
