

Environmental Policy

The purpose of this policy is to outline the commitment of Kangaroo Island Community Broadcasters Inc. to protecting the environment. We encourage our members and our community to continually seek to improve our environmental performance.

POLICY

Kangaroo Island Community Broadcasters Inc. will incorporate environmental factors into organisational decisions and will continually review our environmental performance to enable improvement in reducing our impact on the environment by:

- Utilising local labour and materials, where possible, to reduce carbon kilometres and to support our community.
- Recycling and purchasing recyclable products and equipment where possible.
- Consideration of energy consumption and efficiency as well as more environmentally friendly when purchasing new products and equipment wherever possible.
- Encouraging and training of volunteers in awareness of environmental issues will be offered where possible.

The amount of energy we use will be monitored regularly and volunteers encouraged to reduce consumption as much as possible, for example turning off appliances and all lighting when exiting the premises.

We will encourage our community to improve their environmental performance, for example through relevant community service announcements and programs featuring environment-focussed discussions.
